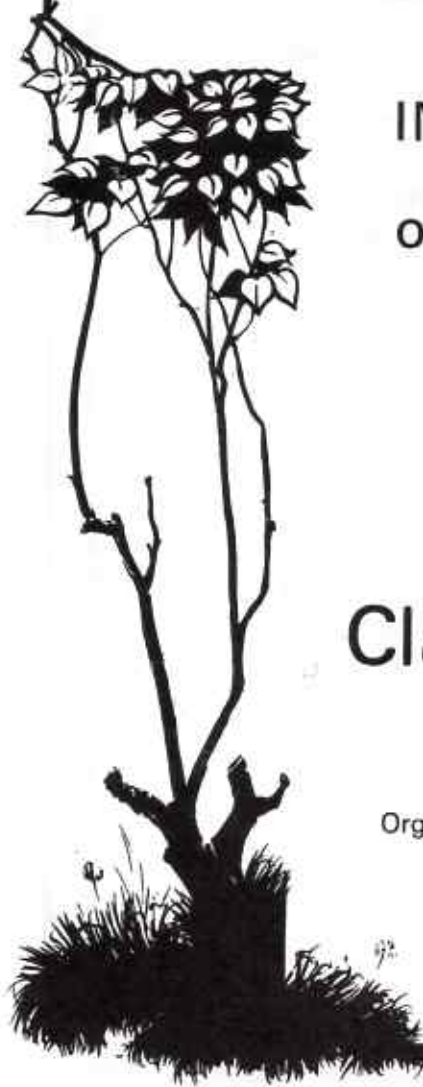

All his work is produced from discarded pieces of wood scavenged from joinery shops — surely a striking example of re-cycling at its best. John is self-taught.

His painting searches for the feeling of the atmosphere of the landscape as affected by the seasonal changes and the effects of wind, rain, sun and snow.
